Practical Nursing Instructor (Part-Time Position)**

The instructor will work under the direction of the Coordinator of Practical Nursing and with PN faculty. A high standard of personal and professional ethics with a sincere interest in teaching and nursing is desired. A criminal background check will be required for the selected applicant.

**Minimum Qualifications:**

- Associate Degree in nursing required; BSN preferred.
- Current TN Registered Nurse license.
- Minimum of 3 years current hospital and/or nursing home experience.
- Previous teaching experience a plus.

**General Duties:**

- Teach full course curriculum; develop course outlines, lesson plans, lectures, and exams.
- Supervise student's clinical experiences as scheduled.
- Provides individual evaluation of each student's progress with counseling and appropriate recommendations when required.
- Maintains confidential, accurate, and complete student records.
- Participate in recruitment of students and placement of graduates.
- Maintains ongoing competency required for RN licensure by participation in continuing education opportunities.
