- The cost of the exam is \$39, payable in cash, debit or Visa/MasterCard. Fee is non-transferable and non-refundable.
- Exam will take place in Building 1, Room 119 (3rd door on left).
- You MUST present an official photo ID before testing.
- Applicants will test only the Math and Reading sections of the HESI Entrance Exam.
- Passing scores are 70 in Math and 70 in Reading.
- Prior ACT Scores (19+ in math & reading) and HESI scores may be submitted if dated within 2 years of start date of class.
